**RE: Community Conversation - Storm Recovery and Response to July 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Flooding Events**

Dear Lebanon Resident:

The July storms created a crisis situation in Lebanon that received national attention. A vast amount of neighborhoods were hit by damaging flash floods, and despite the best efforts of the City's Emergency Management Team to convey information as soon as it has become available, the past two weeks have been frustrating and difficult for some to bear. I would like to thank you all and convey my sincere appreciation for your patience and understanding.

In order to better communicate with residents affected by the storms and flooding, the City will hold a Community Conversation on **Wednesday, July 24, 2013 from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Fireside Inn and Suites, Airport Road, West Lebanon**. This conversation will be an opportunity to hear the latest information on the City's Response and Recovery Plan, and to voice your specific concerns related to our response for these and any future events. Representatives at the meeting will include members of City staff, State Emergency Management, and local businesses and human services agencies.
