Article 02 Long-Term Borrowing

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$14,341,000 (gross budget) for building renovation and construction projects at Hanover Street School and Lebanon High School; and to authorize the issuance of \$14,341,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA Ch.33); and to authorize the School Board to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes and to determine the date, maturities, interest rate, and other details of such bonds or notes; and to raise and appropriate the sum of \$358,525 from taxation for the first year's debt service payments on such bonds or notes; and to authorize the School Board to accept on behalf on the School District any federal, state, or private funds that may become available to fund the project and to use such funds to reduce the amount of bonds or notes issued for the project or to make debt service payments on such bonds or notes.

Article 03 Operating Budget

To see if the School District will raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$48,074,240. Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$47,459,773, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Lebanon School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Article 04 Collective Bargaining Agreement

To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Lebanon School District and the Lebanon Education Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing level:

2023	\$676,420
2024	\$562,221
2025	\$655,803

and further to raise and appropriate \$676,420 for the current fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels.

Article 05 To Add Funds to Lebanon School District Construction and Renovations Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$600,000 to be added to the Lebanon School District Construction and Renovations of School Buildings Capital Reserve Fund previously established. This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1 in excess of \$1,000,000. (The first \$1,000,000 of the June 30 Unassigned Fund Balance will be used to reduce the school tax rate in 2022.) No amount to be raised from taxation.
