Lebanon Recycling Center Guidelines

Scrap Metal	Grill, Toaster, Dryer Pots/Pans, Fans, Car parts, Curtain rods	As is	Metal Recycling Container	No Charge	Stop at Scale House for directions to Metal Recycling Container
Freon containing devices	Refrigerators, Freezers Air Conditioners Dehumidifiers	doors & shelves removed	Behind the Metal container	21 Punches	Stop at Scale House to pay and for directions.
Construction Demolition Debris	Sheet rock, Plywood, PT lumber, Molding Asphalt / Wood shingles, Insulation, Plaster & lath, Rugs	As is	Dirty Wood Pile or Dumpsters	By weight using coupons	See Attendant for disposal location
Furniture	Pull out sofa	As is or with mechanism removed	Furniture Dumpsters	6 punches per item	Includes all furniture, mattresses, couches, chairs, box springs etc....
Propane Tanks	20 lb Gas grill tank	As is	Behind the Metal container	10 Punches	Stop at Scale house to pay and for directions Also in this category- 1 lb camping cylinders
Microwave Ovens	All sizes	As is	Stop at Scale House for Directions	6 Punches	Stop at Scale house to pay and for directions
Fire Extinguisher	Any size	As is	Same as above	10 Punches	Stop at Scale house to pay and for directions
Tires	Passenger Tire	Off the rim	Same as above	5 Punches	Truck tires: 6 coupons - Constr./Farm tires, \$ 200.00 per ton
Yard waste	Leaves/grass clippings	As is	Area behind the dumpsters	No charge	Also included in this category: clumps of sod, soft clippings from shrubs, hay, and weeds. Bags must be emptied out.
Brush	Tree limbs	As is	Same as above	No charge if under 4" in diameter, by punch cards if over 4"	Also included in this category: twigs, bushes, and tree bark/wood pile debris. NO DEMENSIONAL LUMBER OR PALLETS
Electronic Waste	Computer monitors, Televisions, CPU's, VCRs, DVD Players, other electronic devices	As is	Stop at Scale house for Directions	14 punches for monitors 6 punches for electronic devices	Larger TV's and Consoles need to be weighed- Charge is \$.17 lb
Regular Household Trash	Non-Recyclable Waste	Bagged or in trash cans	Stop at Scale house	One coupon (or punch from card) per bag Two punches for contractor bags	Pick-up truck loads of construction and demolition waste is also accepted from residents only with the same fees as household trash.

If you are not recycling.... you are throwing it all away!

There are a number of items that can be easily recycled. Residents are asked to rinse containers, remove caps and place items in the appropriate bins.

Glass – All glass is acceptable. Mix cups, windows, mirrors, bottles and containers. Please, NO light bulbs or tubes.

Plastic – We accept *plastic bottles ONLY* (1-7). Plastic grocery bags are not accepted.

Aluminum – Beverage cans, foil, pie plates and some cat food cans. Use a magnet to be sure it is aluminum. If the magnet doesn't stick....it is aluminum.

Steel Cans – Tuna fish cans, cat food cans and other food cans. If a magnet sticks... it is steel.

Cardboard – Thick brown cardboard. This category will include cardboard boxes, cereal and shoe boxes as well as brown paper bags.

Mixed Paper – If it rips...it is paper. Junk mail, magazines, newspapers, soft cover books, phone books, computer paper, and notebook paper.

Other Items for Recycling

Fluorescent Bulbs – All sizes. Households Only. See attendant for assistance

Mercury Devices – Thermostats, thermometers, mercury switches and other devices.

Rechargeable Batteries – Rechargeable batteries only to be placed in the YELLOW mail drop box. Regular household batteries can be disposed of with regular trash.

Automotive Batteries - See attendant for assistance
Used Motor Oil - Home owner generated motor oil only. Do not mix with gasoline or antifreeze.

Antifreeze - Home owner generated antifreeze.

Used Vegetable Oil - Corn oil, peanut oil, cooking oil. No animal based cooking oil.

Other Electronic Devices and Media Storage – Handheld devices, cell phones and ink cartridges. See attendant.

Pellet Bags – Bags Only must be empty, free of pellets and debris.

Household Hazardous Waste

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) includes items such as paint, pesticides, fertilizers, cleaners, thinners, motor oil and other chemicals that are used by home owners. Regular events are held to collect these items. Ask about upcoming events.

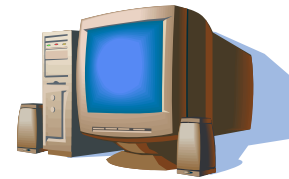
Latex paint should be hardened (using kitty litter or saw dust) and disposed of with regular trash.

Electronics

Television, computer monitors, VCR and DVD players, and CPUs (towers) cannot be disposed of in the landfill.

Please see the scale house attendant for specifics.



Mercury Containing Devices

Items such as thermometers, fluorescent bulbs, thermostats, and some batteries contain mercury. These items can not be disposed on in the landfill. Please see attendant for recycling options and assistance.



Landfill Punch Cards

Landfill Punch Cards can be purchased by residents and businesses at City Hall, West Lebanon Feed & Supply, Lavalley's Hardware and Jake's Market.
