Article 02 Operating Budget

To see if the School District will raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$51,094,870. Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$50,463,877, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Lebanon School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

Article 09 To Add Funds to Lebanon School District Construction Capital Reserve Fund

This sum to come from the June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1 in excess of \$1,000,000. (The first \$1,000,000 of the June 30 Unassigned Fund Balance will be used to reduce the school tax rate in 2023.) No amount to be raised from taxation. **YES**
